If you’re still worried, please raise this with your child’s teacher at their first parents’ evening meeting, or call into the school for a chat.**

Some more comments regarding his personality, peer relationships may be nice in the future

- **Thank you for this observation. This will be fed back to all teachers and to senior leaders who proof-read reports before they go out, so that we can improve on this consistency between teacher’s styles and approaches to writing reports.**
