COVID-19 COMMUNITY SURVEY – JULY 2020 – Summary of feedback and actions

Survey 1: At the end of Summer term Survey 1 was sent out to all families, which sought opinion and concerns surrounding a full return to school in September. Initial results of this were shared at the final FGB Meeting in July. Main concerns raised were:

- Knowing what happens if we were to have a positive case Lots of information, posters and flow charts have been shared with all of our families about this each week from September.
- Wanting regular updates on COVID cases at school This is a feature of weekly newsletters.
- Knowing what safety routines would be in place (handwashing, social distancing, face masks) An updated Q&A was shared in Summer term and again in September as well as the Risk Assessment and details of safety routines.
- Wanting children to have routine temperature checks at school This is not yet stated in guidance and is thought to be unreliable as normal daily practice in schools. We have a thermometer in school should we need to use this and this has been shared with families in the details given out.
